Understanding Bazi



Overview of Four Pillars of Destiny

Four Pillars of Destiny (Bazi) is a logical forecasting system built on the principles of Yin Yang and the Five Elements. A Bazi chart is plotted based on an individual's year, month, date and time of birth

The study of Bazi helps us understand the elemental deficiencies in our chart and identify the favourable elements to create balance, harmony and success. Hence when a Bazi chart achieves elemental balance, you will be presented with opportunities, benefactors and breakthroughs in your career, business, sales and investments

The top row of a Bazi chart is known as the heavenly stem while its bottom row is known as the earthly branches.

The ten heavenly stems are namely Yang Wood, Yin Wood, Yang Fire, Yin Fire, Yang Earth, Yin Earth, Yang Metal, Yin Metal, Yang Water and Yin Water.

The twelve different earthly branches are made up of the twelve chinese zodiac animals. Each zodiac animal represents one of the five elements of either yin or yang polarity.

Definition of Favourable Elements

Favourable elements are elements which can help us achieve elemental balance in our Bazi chart. Every Bazi chart would have two or three favourable Bazi elements to create balance.

Every favourable element has corresponding auspicious colours:

Metal elemental colour: White
Water elemental colours: Black and Blue
Wood elemental colour: Green
Fire elemental colours: Red and Lavender
Earth elemental colours: Yellow and
Brown











Imperial Feng Shui master would apply these favourable elements to empower us to be in a state of consistent good luck. With this, we can maximise our life potential and achieve financial success, whether that's six-figure monthly sales commissions, high-paid and fulfilling jobs, or consistent growth in our investments.

The Principles of Yin & Yang

Before the universe morphed into and took its present form, all was vague and amorphous.


Although life existed, it was unable to sustain itself. In the study of I-Ching (易 经), this phenomena is theorised as the Great Ultimate / the Great Beginning / Wu Ji (无极).

Over time, the universe gradually began to produce material forces. Forces which were clear and light drifted upwards to form the Heavens. Those that were heavy and turgid contrastingly solidified to form the Earth.

The combined essence of Heaven and Earth is known today as **Tai Ji** (太极).

Borne out of a conceptually whole reality stipulated within **Tai Ji**, **Yin & Yang** (阴阳) are thought of as complementary forces.

In Tai Ji, the symbols of Yin & Yang are joined in harmony to form a S-shaped jigsaw of black and white.



When the substance of Yin is separated from its accompanying Yang substance, the primal energies of life stimulating evolution are created.

In the diagram of Yin and Yang, the segments are further divided into what is known as the Four Phenomena.

The Four Phenomena are known as Major Yang, Major Yin, Minor Yang, and Minor Yin.

The Four Phenomena represent:

the Four Seasons: Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter the Four Life Stages: Birth, Aging, Sickness, and Death the Four Directions: East, South, West and North

The Four Phenomena are then further divided into the Ba Gua, which serves as the basis of Imperial Feng Shui.

Metal, Wood, Water, Fire and Earth form the basic components of all matter in the world. Forming a universal framework, the Five Elements govern our daily lives, the opportunities we come across and the people we meet.

Each individual is unique - some of us are born with more "wood" in our destiny charts while others are perhaps born with more "earth". Such permutations of our Five Elements are dictated by the time, date, month and year of birth, as reflected in every Bazi chart.

Understanding our birth charts will reveal to us our lifetime favourable and unfavourable elements.

Earthly Branches represent the root and foundation of a Bazi chart. For an element to be considered strong, it has to appear in the Earthly Branches. In an Imperial Feng Shui Master's terminology, a strong element is rooted.

There are four possible locations for your favourable element to be rooted namely the Yearly Branch, Monthly Branch, Day Branch and Hour Branch.

If your favourable element is rooted in the **Hour** Branch, it is deemed as the third strongest root. If your favourable element is rooted in the **Day** Branch, it is deemed as the second strongest root. If your favourable element is rooted in the **Month** Branch, it is deemed as the strongest root. If your favourable element is rooted in the **Year** Branch, it is deemed as the fourth strongest root.



















Applied accurately, each individual's favourable elements empower them to be in a state of consistently good luck - placing them in good stead to achieve career, sales, investment and business breakthroughs.

In dynastic China, an appointed Imperial Feng Shui Master was responsible for prescribing and blessing elemental jadeite pendants, rings or beads for important members of the Chinese royal family.


Every individual has the choice to improve their luck, to achieve consistent progress and astounding breakthroughs in their business, sales, career and investment endeavours.
